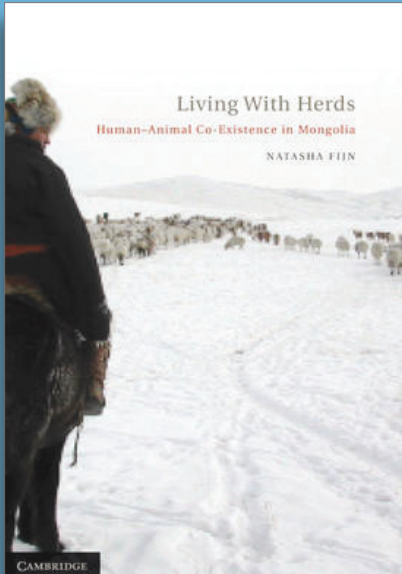

Living With Herds: Human-Animal Coexistence in Mongolia

Domestic animals have lived with humans for thousands of years and remain essential within the everyday lives of people throughout the world. In this book, Natasha Fijn examines the process of animal domestication in a study that blends biological and social anthropology, ethology, and ethnography. She examines the social behavior of humans and animals in a contemporary Mongolian herding society.

While living with Mongolian herding families and their herd animals, Dr. Fijn observed both sides of the human–animal relationship.

Examining their reciprocal social behavior and communication with one another, she demonstrates how herd animals influence Mongolian herders and how the animals themselves are active partners in the domestication process.
